Moruya Men's Open Conditions of Play

- The event is open to all male amateurs, who are members of a recognized Golf Club affiliated with a state or overseas association, who have a current verifiable AGU handicap.
- Entries must be nominated on the entry form, or a photocopy of the entry form and be accompanied by a cheque, cash, credit card or EFT payment. Entries and payment can also be accepted online.
- The entry fee is \$50 for the two days of golf or \$30 for a single day.
- The Moruya Golf Club Match Committee is responsible for the organisation of the event and their decision is final.
- The Match Committee has the sole control of the event and reserves the right to vary conditions should they deem it advisable. The Match Committee will decide any disputes/protest and their decision shall be final.
- All players must be ready to commence play 15 minutes prior to their scheduled tee time.
- Rule 5.6b will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group proceeding it. **Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position.** Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.
- Players may accept only one trophy during the event, other than novelty events.
- In the event of a tie for the Overall Gross, a sudden-death play-off over holes 1,17 and 18 will determine the winner.
- Ties in the Nett competitions will be determined by count back as described in the Australian Count Back System.
- The rules of The Royal and Ancient Golf Club St Andrews and the Local Rules of the Moruya Golf Club shall be the rules of play for this event.
